find that the identity of the deceased was [REDACTED]

and the death occurred on 5 February 2008 at Epworth

Brightview, 85 Willow St, Brightview

from Complications of a massive hemorrhage under the following circumstances:

1. The deceased, [REDACTED], was a 21 year old who resided at the Brightview Achievement Grounds at 86 Carpenter St, Brightview. [REDACTED] had been in that facility for approximately 16 years to the care of her parents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

On the 5 February 2008 [REDACTED] presented at Epworth Brightview with massive hemorrhage from a self-inflicted injury to the Anterior Cervical Region. Her condition was diagnosed as terminal, and through consultation with [REDACTED]'s family the decision was made to treat palliatively. At approximately 11.17 pm on 05/02/2008 [REDACTED] was found deceased in Bed 5, Ground West Wing at Epworth Brightview, Brightview. There are no suspicious circumstances surrounding [REDACTED]'s expected death.
